
Get Ready...Get Ready!!! The 2024 Alumni Conference is only four weeks away and there will be plenty activities appealing to all age groups!

Riverboat Cruises - tickets and reservations available at the concierge desk

The Savannah Riverboat Cruises include these options:

Narrated Harbor Sightseeing Cruises at 1:00 and 3:30 - an hour and a 1/2 cruise with the captain, fascinating you with tales of Savannah's history and the modern day port. \$37. This cruise is available most days of the week.

Dinner Entertainment Cruise with a delicious buffet dinner live entertainment. Boarding at 6 PM, sailing 7 to 9 PM - about \$85, Saturday \$110

The **Savannah Harbor Cruises** offer 3 tours - This pontoon style boat that holds 49 passengers offers a more intimate experience with the river



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Port Tour - 1.5 hour tour of the Port of Savannah - detailed factual tour of the largest singly owned container port in North America - 10 AM

Dolphin Tours - 2 hour tour of the Savannah River and salt marsh where many Dolphins live and play - 1 PM and 4 PM

Sunset Cruise - 2 hour tour of the Savannah River, enjoying the night air, the sunset and the lights of the city as you return. (Times vary with sunset)

Transportation Services

Old Town Trolley Tour - I would recommend a hop off and on trolley tour because it will give you a nice overview of the city.

15 stops - Trolleys every 15-20 minutes - continuous 100 point live narration - 90 minutes.

\$28 - 46 depending on when it is purchased, Second Day - half of the regular price when purchased.

Ferry - The Savannah Belle Ferry system operates from 8:15 AM until 6:15 PM daily. It comes every 30 minutes and provides transportation to the City Hall area and the Convention Center across the river. FREE

UBER and LYFT - these two services are very active and available throughout the day and evening.

Taxis - Taxis are good to get to the airport, but usually not interested in providing transportation for short distances downtown.

Downtowner - Free UBER like service of the city - operates 5 PM - 5 AM - only within the Historic District - must download app and be in the district to request ride

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DOT Shuttle - city bus - free - no narration - 2 routes (east/west, north/south) - goes to Starland District - 7 AM - 7 PM

Ghost Tours - tickets available at the concierge desk

This is a fun and entertaining ghost story tour. Not very scary and very historic. Nothing made up.

Ghosts and Gravestones - Exclusive Nighttime Entry into Two of Savannah's Most Haunted Places - the Andrew Low House and Perkins and Sons Ship Chandlery. \$4 off when a trolley ticket is also purchased - \$32-\$42 depending on the time and the availability.

Ghost Town Trolley - A creepier and scarier tour that is a hybrid, walking and trolley tour. About 2/3 on the trolley hearing stories about the various places you pass, and 1/3 walking around the outside of the Colonial Park Cemetery and 2 of the most haunted squares in Savannah, hearing the various stories related to them.

Ghost Hunters of Savannah Paranormal Investigation - This is a 135 minute experience of actually using the latest ghost hunting equipment to explore the eerie enigma of 416 W. Liberty Street a place steeped in history, myth, and chilling tales. Small group experience (12 maximum) (8:55 PM and 11:55 PM)

There are also the following museums and other tours - tickets available at the concierge desk

Award winning **Prohibition Museum** - wax figures, vintage cars, costumed actors, tells story of Prohibition from beginning of the colony through roaring 20's, Al Capone era and even the reason we have NASCAR today. \$16 - \$18 w/Trolley Ticket as a package

Massie Heritage Center - museum - about \$8

Carriage Rides - day and evening about \$32

House Tours - Andrew Low House about \$15, Davenport House about \$15, Harper Fowlkes House about \$12

Webb Military Museum about \$10

Ships of the Sea Museum about \$8
